Beginning on the first Thursday in October, this field trip can last the entire day. Teachers,




children and their parents will enjoy all activities associated with the valley's premier fall event. Schnepf Farms Pumpkin & Chili features enough activities to keep the children happy all day long. Activities include: Hay rides, carousel rides, a four acre corn maze, Hill-billy Bob's Pig Races, a comedy and juggling show, rides, petting barn Inflatables, rock climbing wall and more. Plus each child will be able to pick a small pumpkin from the 1 acre pumpkin patch. There are several educational
